**A rise in accidental opioid overdoses in Alberta has prompted renewed calls for action to combat the opioid crisis. Nearly 4 Albertans die everyday from accidental overdose, well surpassing deaths related to the COVID-19 pandemic.**

**Our proximity to downtown and the river valley means we may be able to help individuals who have accidentally overdosed.**

In partnership with **Dr. Shazma Mithani** (an ER doctor at the Royal Alexandra Hospital), **Michael Rees** (pharmacist at Crestwood Apothecary), and **Streetworks Edmonton**, **Crestwood Community League** is hosting a Naloxone Kit Training Session.
