

# SNOW CLEARING SERVICE LEVELS

Edmonton

When it snows our crews are out. When snowfall stops, our priority clearing system begins.

## ROADWAYS

### PRIORITY 1

Main freeways and arterial roadways, downtown business district and hills.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 1 DAY**

### PRIORITY 2

Remaining freeways, arterial roadways, business districts, collector roadways, Transit Park and Ride access roads.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 5 DAYS**

### PRIORITY 3

Industrial areas and rural roadways.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 6 DAYS**

### PRIORITY 4

Residential roadways are completed as part of a Phase 2 Parking Ban.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 10 DAYS**

## ACTIVE PATHWAYS

### PRIORITY 1

City facilities, Winter Priority Bike Loop.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 1 DAY**

### PRIORITY 2

City sidewalks, ramps, staircases, bike lanes, shared paths, pedestrian bridges and bus stop access.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 3 DAYS**

### PRIORITY 3

Manually cleared paths, bus stop benches and pads.

 **COMPLETED WITHIN 14 DAYS**

### PRIORITY 4

Community sandboxes, safe mobility devices.

 **COMPLETED WHEN RESOURCES ALLOW**

## PARKING BANS

Snow clearing is a shared responsibility. Have a plan before we call a parking ban.

### PHASE 1

Major roads including core business areas and bus routes.



**LASTS UP TO 5 DAYS**

### PHASE 2

Residential and industrial areas.

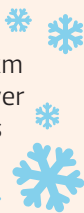


**LASTS UP TO 10 DAYS - ONCE A BAN IS ACTIVATED**

Vehicles in place once the ban is in effect are subject to ticketing.

### DID YOU KNOW?

The City clears over 500 km of active pathways and over 12,000 km of roads. That's almost as far as going to England and back.



### SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

To help increase safety and accessibility, property owners are responsible for clearing the front and sides of their property as soon as possible after it snows.

### SIDEWALKS

Property owners can add salt and sand to icy sidewalks. Failure to maintain sidewalks could result in a \$100 fine. Sand is available at 100 community sandbox locations.

### LIVE MAP

Watch the plows in action on the live map. When a snow event occurs, the map also displays the clearing status of every roadway.

### CENTRE WINDROWS

A long line of snow heaped up along the centre of the road will be picked up within 5 days of their priority level being completed.

**ALLEYS** are completed as part of the same priority as their adjacent roadway.
